Junior & Senior Scholar of the Week Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the Scholar of the Week award, applicant must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Attend a public school system located in Central Virginia;
- 2. Be enrolled as a junior or senior in high school for the current academic year;
- 3. Have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher;
- 4. Be a participant in extracurricular community service activities.

Eligibility Documents

- 1. Complete the accompanying application
- 2. Provide report card and transcript of most recent grading period
- 3. List your extracurricular, community, church or other activities in the order of importance to you. Indicate the dates you participated in the activity, positions held and the number of hours per week you spend on each activity. We realize that the way you spend your time outside the classroom may be affected by factors beyond your control, such as the need to work.
- 4. Write a 250 500 word personal essay describing hobbies, interests and plans for the future.
- 5. Please ask two individuals who know you well, but are not related to you, to submit letters of recommendation. At least one should be from a teacher or other school professional.
